Dr. Chroneos has been a member of the American Hellenic Educational Progressive Association (AHEPA) since 2015. He has joined AHEPA's effort to find cures and treatments for Cooley's anemia, a severe form of  $\beta$ -Thalassemia of high genetic prevalence in individuals with Greek heritage. In addition to his research on viral and bacterial pneumonia, he has assembled a team of clinicians, medical students, basic and public health researchers to advance public health awareness and research on  $\beta$ -Thalassemia in coordination with medical and public health authorities, Greek Orthodox communities, and AHEPA at local, regional, and national levels. He was appointed to AHEPA's National Cooley's Anemia Foundation Committee in July 2019.

#### Markos Papadatos Power Journalist

Markos Papadatos is Digital Journal's Editor-at-Large for Music News, a Managing Editor for Raver Magazine, and a Senior Editor for the Hellenic News of America. He also serves as an Associate Producer of the Telly Award-winning TV show "The Donna Drake Show" on CBS New York. Meropi Kyriacou was born in Nicosia, Cyprus. She is a graduate of the School of Law and Political Science of the National and Kapodistrian University of Athens. She has a postgraduate Master's Degree in Humanities and she is currently completing her PhD/Doctorate Degree. She has worked for several years as an editor in newspapers and magazines. #### Vasilis Kolovos Kolovos Enterprises

Vasilios Bill Kolovos migrated to the United States from Greece in 1968. When arriving in Elizabeth, NJ Bill began working in the Thatcher Glass Company bottle factory as a bottle maker. He began working in the factory as an entry level oven worker and climbed his way up the latter to Assistant General Manager. He gave his notice in 1973 after working enough overtime and saving enough money to start up his own business, which at the time was his dream. In early 1974 he married Angela Kolovos, which became his business partner for good.

Then in mid 1974 Bill attended and graduated from the Boston Dunkin Donuts School. There he learned how to build, establish and operate his first Dunkin Donuts. He built and opened his first Dunkin Donuts in Geneva NY. This Dunkin Donuts became a model store for the Northern New York region and topped all sales number projected by corporate. This is where he also met his future business partner Manwell Baroody, who came to work for him as a General Manager. In 1974 Bill also opened and operated his second Dunkin Donuts in Newark, NY. These Dunkin Donuts were sold in 1983 & 1984 because Bill wanted to pursue an even bigger business, the diner business.

Bill bought into the Town & Country Diner with a few partners in 1984. They operated the Town & Country Diner for 4 years as he learned all of the in and outs of the industry. In 1988 he sold his shares to his partners and decided to pursue the next level of the hospitality industry and with much control of the project.

In 1989, Bill found an old restaurant & banquet hall in south New Jersey named Lucien's Manor that was in foreclosure and he believed that he could turn this old Landmark into a new thriving business once again. The Lucien's story is a long one. For the first five years Bill tried to keep Lucien's as a high class restaurant, and this worked, but it did not provide the profits that he believed a place of this stature should. With Lucien's being so large, Bill began renovating various parts of the restaurant and created a Bar/NightClub along with separate catering space. In 1995, Bill and Manwell, his only partner in Lucien's at the time, noticed the potential in the Banquet Sector. So in 1997 they decided to turn strictly to banquets, thus meaning the end of all restaurant & bar business. From 1997 to 2000, Lucien's was so successful that Bill decided to do a three stage, \$10 Million renovation of the entire restaurant. This is the time that his son Hristos Chris Kolovos bought into the business and helped Bill and Manwell oversee all of the renovations along as take over all Managerial Duties. Today Lucien's has become the premiere catering hall in New Jersey.

While Lucien's was succeeding, Bill decided to purchase another diner with different partners. In 1993 Bill purchased the Oregon Diner in South Philadelphia. He quickly came in and renovated the entire restaurant and overhauled the menu. The Oregon Diner quickly became a South Philadelphia landmark once again.

In 1997, due largely to the success of the Oregon Diner, Bill decided to purchase the Penrose Diner also in South Philadelphia about 3 miles away from the Oregon Diner. The Penrose, at the time of purchase, was in an absolute desolate state. Bill this time, closed down the restaurant for over a month and remodeled the entire place. It didn't take long again till the Penrose Diner began putting up phenomenal numbers. The Penrose is another Philadelphia landmark. In 2009 the Penrose has also been the subject of its 3rd renovation which encompasses the entire interior and exterior of the restaurant.

Bill has since been involved with the purchase of the Mansion on Main Street in 2018. He is part of the ownership group that oversees the management group that has helped turn the mansion around. He is pivotal in helping with the design efforts for the multimillion dollar renovation scheduled to begin in January 2020.

Bill also played a major role in acquiring, designing and building Olga's Diner in Marlton NJ. The diner is a 275 seat restaurant that was a \$3mm project to build. It opened in October of 2019 and has been getting rave reviews.

Bill along with his son Hristos Chris also helps in the day to day overseeing of their approx. \$25 mm investment portfolio
